Consumer Survey for June 2024

SUMMARY

☐ The Composite Consumer Sentiment Index (CCSI) for June 2024 stood at 100.9, higher than that in May by 2.5 points.
 Consumer sentiment regarding current living standards was two points higher than in May, at 90, and that concerning the future outlook was two points higher than in the previous month, at 94.
 Consumer sentiment related to future household income was two points higher than in May, at 99, and that concerning future household spending was unchanged at 109.
 Consumer sentiment concerning current domestic economic conditions was four points higher than in May, at 71, and that concerning future domestic economic conditions was one point higher than in the previous month, at 80.
\square The expected inflation rate for the upcoming year was 3.0%.
** Between June 11 and 18, 2024, exactly 2,500 households nationwide were surveyed, and among them 2,308 responded.
